Background

Applications for membership of the RHS Golfing Society are welcomed and we maintain our friendly, open approach to making golf accessible, affordable, sociable and enjoyable for all. We have a waiting list of applicants, and we have a policy to prioritise applications for membership. General principles for prioritising applications are as below.

Prioritisation

All applications must be Proposed and Seconded by existing members (who are limited to Proposing one new member in each golfing year). Applications are prioritised against these criteria:

- Players who have played the course as green-fee-paying Guests, accompanied by an
 existing member (or members), on at least three separate occasions, and using our
 tee-time booking system. Green fees of £5 (9 holes) or £10 (18 holes) should be paid
 to the RHS Golfing Society account, for which details can be provided. Applications
 not meeting this requirement will not be approved.
- 2. Applicants living locally (i.e. within a reasonable vicinity of Holbrook and the Shotley peninsula).
- 3. Family relatives and friends of existing members.
- 4. Staff and students of the Royal Hospital School, including ex-students and retired staff.
